## **DONATION GUIDELINES**

Consider supporting our mission with a donation from your business, organization, or historic site. Your donation to *See You at the Station* will be auctioned off at our live or silent auction, and all proceeds will result in an investment in the promotion of federal programs that protect our cultural and environmental resources and inspire the next generation of preservation advocates.

The donation of exceptional items for the auction has been the hallmark of its decades-long success. Donated items included in the silent auction will be photographed, advertised, and displayed on our bidding website and shipped directly to the auction winner after the event.

One of the reasons for the success of the auctions has been the variety of items up for sale. Big and small, modestly priced or expensive, auction items often reflect regional historic flavor and historic preservation accomplishment. The items that are most successful are those that the lucky winner can boast, "I cannot believe I was able to get this, and it was such a great deal!" Some of the items featured in past auctions include:

- Travel packages to historic places including lodging in historic buildings and dining opportunities
- Books about historic places, objects and individuals, local and regional histories
- Framed art and collectors' items
- Memberships and tickets to special events
- Historic preservation services such as National Register nominations, historical research on specific properties, and technology-related services like graphics or web design
- Personally guided tours and tickets to annual historic tours or historic festivals

#### **HOW TO DONATE**

Alternatively, items can be mailed to Preservation Action Foundation, 2020 Pennsylvania Avenue NW #313, Washington, DC 20006. **All printed materials accompanying the donation must fit within a standard 8x11" manila envelope.** 

**All auction items will need to be photographed for display online.** Please include website links, brochures, photographs, or other information that will help the bidders better understand the item.

For items larger than a standard 8x11" envelope (books, artwork, gift baskets, etc), please photograph the items for inclusion in the auction. **Donors are requested to retain their items after they are photographed and plan to have them shipped to the auction item winner after the event.** Staff will notify donors of the mailing addresses of the winners shortly after the date of the auction.

We cannot accept donations of alcohol unless items can be shipped directly to the auction winner from the winery/distributor/brewery upon notification by Preservation Action Foundation of the auction result.
