WHAT ARE TRIBAL HISTORIC PRESERVATION OFFICERS?

THPOs are Tribal government officials who protect culturally important places that perpetuate Native identity, resilience, and cultural endurance. THPOs assume the duties of State Historic Preservation Officers

on Tribal land, grounded in sovereignty, traditional knowledge, and cultural values. THPOs complete required reviews for Tribal projects as well as national energy and infrastructure development.

WHAT IS AT STAKE?

Connections to cultural heritage sustain the health and vitality of Native peoples, helping heal generational trauma. THPOs also complete required reviews for energy and infrastructure development.

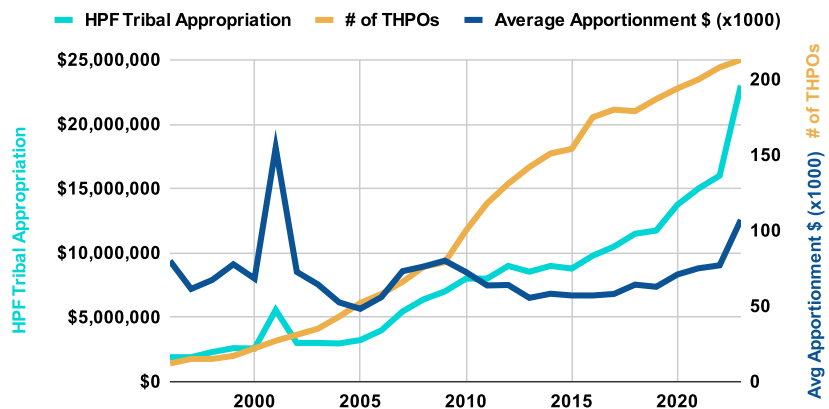
As the number of Tribes with a THPO increases, the funding for this federal program must keep pace: **in 1996, there were 12 THPOs; in 2023, there were 212 THPOs who got an average of \$108,000 each.**

IT IS ESSENTIAL THAT THPO PROGRAM FUNDING REFLECTS THE GROWING NUMBER OF THPOS.

OUR REQUEST

\$34 million to carry out the requirements of the National Historic Preservation Act. This would provide the **221 total THPOs an average of \$154,000 each** (current funding only averages \$108,000 per THPO) to run their programs, which create jobs, generate economic development, and spur community revitalization.

HISTORIC PRESERVATION FUND APPROPRIATIONS FOR TRIBES



The **number of THPOs** increases each year. For the **average apportionment per THPO** to actually increase, the **HPF Tribal appropriation** must keep pace.

WHAT DO THPOS DO?

- Work with law enforcement to apprehend and prosecute looters of ancestral remains and sacred objects
- First responders when a sacred site is threatened or Native ancestors are disturbed by development
- Create their Tribe's oral history programs and operate Tribal museums and cultural centers
- Locate, survey, record and maintain inventories of Tribal historic resources
- Review federal projects for their impact on Tribal historic resources
- Nominate properties to the National Register of Historic Places
- Lead revitalization of cultural traditions and native languages
