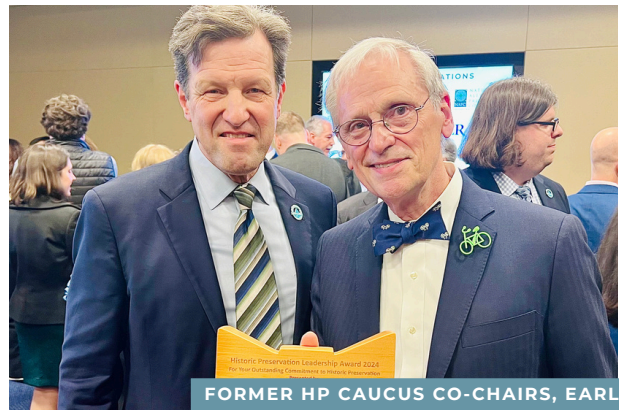


Historic Preservation Caucus

Co-chaired by Representatives Mike Turner (R-OH) & Teresa Leger-Fernández (D-NM), the Historic Preservation Caucus serves as a forum for members to discuss ways to protect and revitalize America’s historic places. The bipartisan Historic Preservation Caucus is comprised of new and seasoned Representatives that work together to support preservation & economic development by advocating for historic preservation legislation, including funding needs. National preservation organizations work closely with the Caucus on initiatives throughout the year, including a Preservation Month briefing each May, organized by Preservation Action.

From rural Main Streets to modest row homes, communities across the country have historic places that help tell the story of America. Preserving these historic places is an essential element of creating a community’s sense of place. Through programs such as the Federal Historic Tax Credit, historic buildings help drive economic development. Heritage tourism, downtown commercial revitalization, and the rehabilitation and adaptive reuse of historic properties into housing, are a few ways we can appreciate history. The Caucus supports these initiatives by championing legislation that advances historic preservation throughout the country.
